ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST CONTACT THE INSTRUCTOR PRIOR TO REGISTERING.

Pre-requisites: Participants must be strong swimmers and must be at least 15 years of age or have completed the 8th grade. Annual Health & Medical Record form required. Swimming and Lifesaving Merit Badges are recommended.

Certification: Certified B.S.A. Lifeguards are counted as Qualified Supervision for Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat when conducting aquatic activities in Scouting. ARC First Aid, ARC CPR.

Shooting Sports

Cub Scout Shooting Sports Trek

At Camp La-No-Che

COST: \$45.00

This Trek is for Volunteer Staff who will be serving as the Shooting Sports Director for Cub Scout Day Camp or any other District or Council Level Activity. Cub Scout Shooting Sports can only be conducted at Council or District Sponsored events and can not be conducted as a Pack Program.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST HAVE APPROVAL FROM THEIR DISTRICT EXECUTIVE OR THE DIRECTOR OF CAMPING AND PROPERTIES PRIOR TO REGISTRATION (Director of Camping & Properties, Matt Ragan, can be contacted at 352-552-7711).

Pre-requisites: Must be at least 21 years of age and be willing to serve as a shooting sports director for a district or council level event. Must have approval from one of the above mentioned staff. **Contact your DE for approval.**

Program: The program will focus on how to instruct Cub Scouts in Archery and B.B. Gun Safety and how to properly set up Archery and B.B. Gun ranges. Each participant will receive a current copy of the Cub Scout Shooting Sports handbook.

Certification: Participants who complete this course may fulfill the National Camp Standard as a Shooting Sports Director for a Council or District Cub Scout event.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST HAVE APPROVAL FROM THE COURSE INSTRUCTOR PRIOR TO REGISTRATION.

Pre-requisites: Must be 21 years of age. Must have approval from the course instructor.

Program: First class is Saturday April 18th @ 8:00am at the Council Service Center. Top notch training program designed with boys and safety in mind. Fee includes all program materials, ammunition, use of firearms, and certification.

Includes: Rifle, Shotgun, Pistol, Home Firearm Safety, and Range Safety Officer.

Certification: Participants who successfully complete this course will have their NRA Rifle, Shotgun and Home Firearm Safety Instructor certification which will allow them to be registered Rifle Merit Badge and/or Shotgun Merit Badge Counselors. This certification also allows the participant to conduct shooting sports programs for their Troop or Crew.
